Shop for goods from all over the world at over 100 shops and specialty pushcarts.

Be A Part Of History

In 1742, Peter Faneuil built Faneuil Hall as a gift to the city. It provided a platform for the country's most famous orators. It is where colonists first protested the Sugar Act in 1764 and established the doctrine of "no taxation without representation". It is where Samuel Adams rallied the citizens of Boston to the cause of independence from Great Britain and George Washington toasted the nation on its first birthday. Through the years, Faneuil Hall has played host to many impassioned speakers, from Oliver Wendell Holmes and Susan B. Anthony to Bill Clinton and Barack Obama.

To better accommodate the merchants and shoppers, Faneuil Hall was expanded in 1826 to include Quincy Market followed by North and South Markets. Quincy Market was dubbed for Boston Mayor Josiah Quincy. The market remained a vital business hub throughout the 19th century; but by the mid-1900's, the buildings had fallen into despair. Through the vision of Jim Rouse, architect Benjamin Thompson, and Mayor Kevin White, the dilapidated structures were revitalized, thoroughly changing the face of downtown Boston.

The 1976 renovation was the first urban renewal of its kind, one that spawned imitations in this country and abroad. Now celebrating its 40th anniversary in 2016, this urban marketplace attracts millions of visitors annually...including celebrities such as Jimmy Fallon, Ellen DeGeneres, Gisele Bundchen and Tom Brady!

Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company Museum


Tour: Visit this free museum on the 4th floor of Historic Faneuil Hall Monday through


